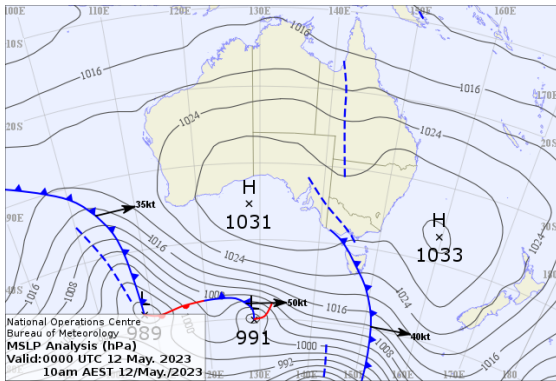


**Weather Briefing 1515 Friday 12th May**  
**2023 Valid 1530-1830**

**Situation:** A ridge of high pressure extends from a high in the Bight across Western Australia, resulting in a northwesterly airflow, while a cold front approaches from the west. Continuing sunny.



**SURFACE WIND:** 280/04-07kt.

**WEATHER:** Nil significant.

**CLOUD:** Nil significant.

**VISIBILITY:** Unrestricted.

**TURB:** Possible thermals on launch.

**TEMP:** 23c falling to 19c by 1800.

**AREA QNH:** 1020.

**SUNSET:** 1730

**REMARKS:** Possible thermals until 1630.
