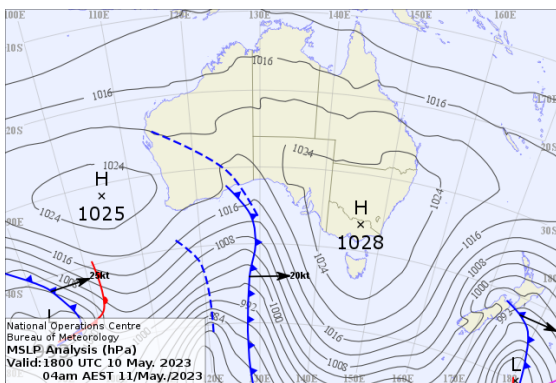


Weather Briefing 0530 Thursday 11th
May 2023 Valid 0630-1000

Situation: A cold front to the east continues to move eastwards as a high pressure system builds to the west. This high is directing a cool west to southwesterly airflow across southern parts of Western Australia. A few fog patches followed by a partly cloudy day with light winds.



SURFACE WIND: VRB/02kts.

WEATHER: Fog patches possible.

CLOUD: SCT 4500ft.

VISIBILITY: 500m in fog otherwise unrestricted.

TURB: Nil significant.

TEMP: 07c rising to 13c by 1000. Max 18c

AREA QNH: 1024.

SUNRISE 0651.

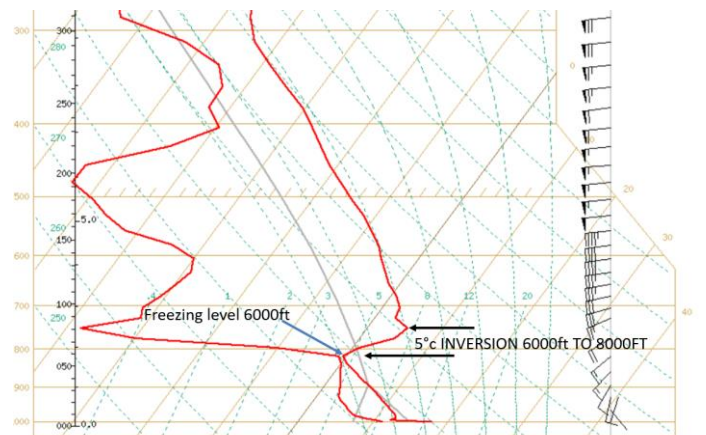
REMARKS: Freezing level 6000ft.
