


## Weather Briefing 0530 Thursday 11th May 2023 Valid 0630-1000

**Situation:** A cold front to the east continues to move eastwards as a high pressure system builds to the west. This high is directing a cool west to southwesterly airflow across southern parts of Western Australia. A few fog patches followed by a partly cloudy day with light winds.



**SURFACE WIND:** VRB/02kts.

**WEATHER:** Fog patches possible.

CLOUD: SCT 4500ft.

**VISIBILITY:** 500m in fog otherwise unrestricted.

TURB: Nil significant.

**TEMP**: 07c rising to 13c by 1000. Max 18c

**AREA QNH:** 1024.

**SUNRISE** 0651.

**REMARKS:** Freezing level 6000ft.
