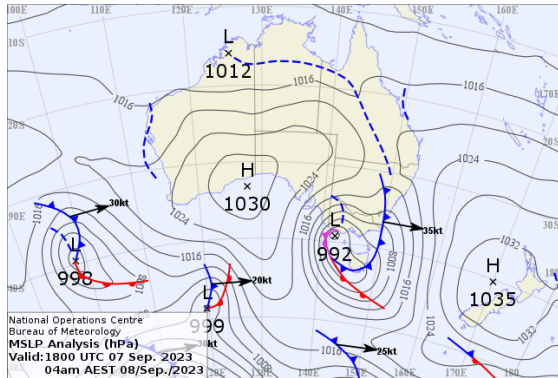




**Weather Briefing 0515 Friday 8th
