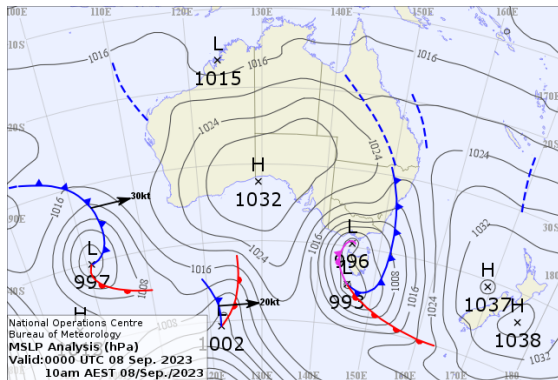


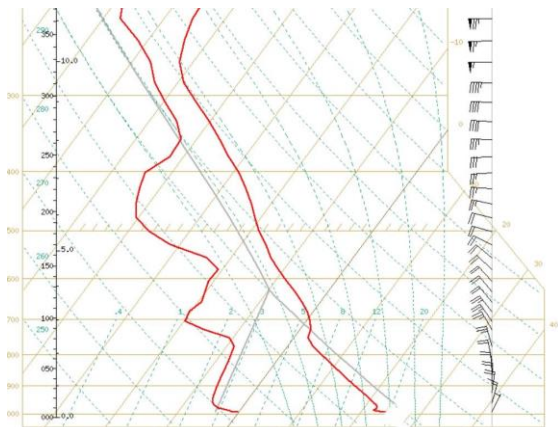


**Weather Briefing 1515 Friday 8th
September 2023 Valid 1530-1800**

Situation: A high pressure system in the Great Australian Bight is directing a dry north to northeasterly airflow over Western Australia. Sunny and clear for the remainder of the day. A cold front approaching from the west will tighten the pressure gradient overnight, causing stronger winds in the morning.

- TEMP:** 24c falling to 21c by 1800.
