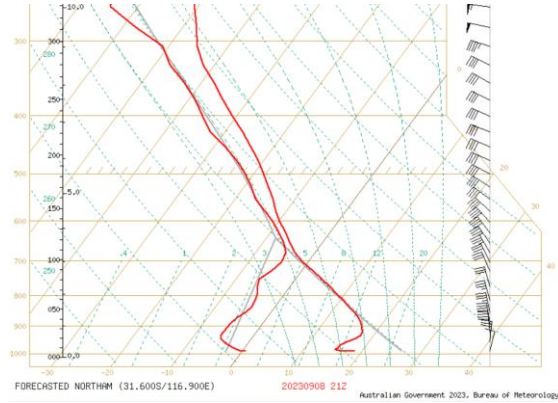
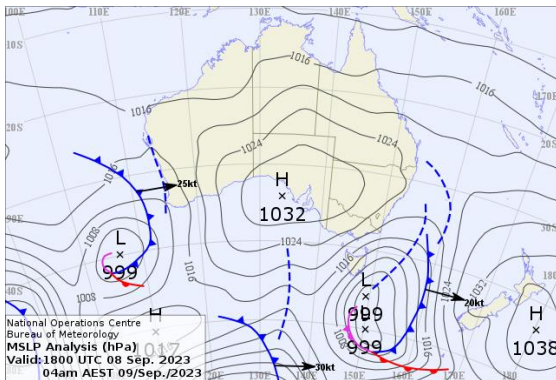




**Weather Briefing 0515 Saturday 9th
September 2023 Valid 0600-1000**

Situation: A high pressure system in the Great Australian Bight is directing a northerly airflow over Western Australia. A cold front to the west coupled with a low pressure trough will move through the local area later this afternoon and bring a westerly change with a shower or two and a possible storm.
