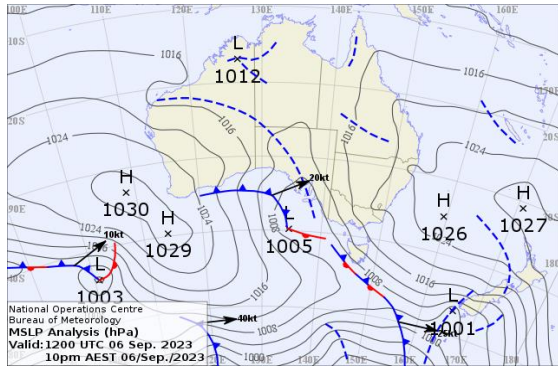




**Weather Briefing 0515 Thursday 7th

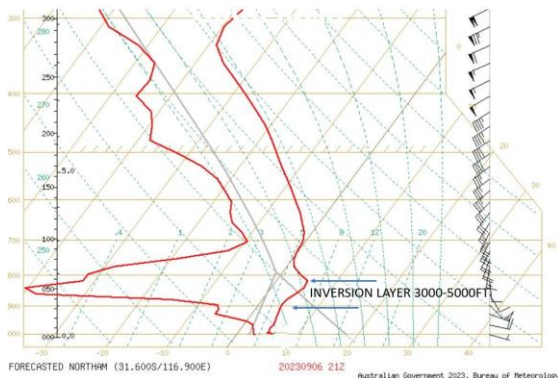
