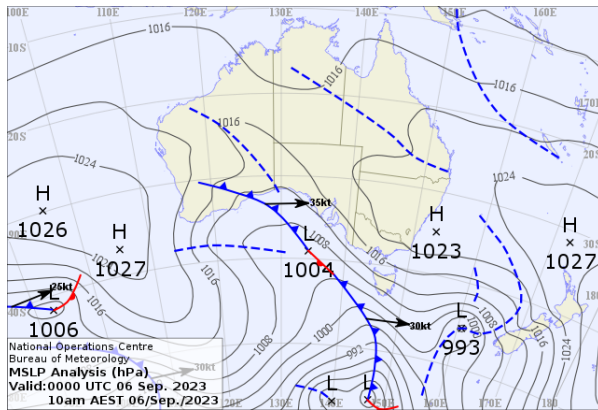




**Weather Briefing 1515 Wednesday 6th
