



Response to Letter from Competitor #9 Regarding Task 3

To Competitor #9 – Les Springett.

You have expressed concern about your result in Task 3. The Official version of the results for task 3 was published on both the Official Notice Board and the Electronic Notice Board at 11:45 AM on 28 May 2019.

Any complaint regarding a task must be submitted to the Director within eight hours of publication of the official scores for a task (Rule 5.6.1.2). Following expiry of this eight hour period, the results are made "FINAL" in accordance with Rule 14.3.3. Given this, the results for task 3 became "FINAL" at 19:45 on Tuesday 28 May 2019. The FINAL results were published on the Official Notice Board and the Electronic Notice Board at 19:45 on 28 May 2019.

Your concerns were received at 09:05 on Wednesday 29 May 2019. Therefore I am unable to accept these as a "complaint" defined in Rule 5.2 or consider amending the results based on the arguments you put forward. The FINAL results for task 3 stand as published.

I will however make some comments in response to the matters you raise in your letter. If I were to score you to the goal that you would prefer, you would obtain a result of 67 metres. However, as this goal was declared at 06:57:07 (17 mins and 5 secs after the green flag) you would also receive a penalty of 900 points.

I understand that the primary intent of your letter was to correct the record to reflect your ability to fly to your chosen goal. I hope this response goes someway to addressing this concern.
