 Pilot declared Coordinates must be given with Altitude in ft. In case of a missing altitude for the declared coordinate we use the last valid Goal declaration for this task.
- Official CLP Coordinate: CLP 1 50866/2836 892ft
- Rules II.6 and II.7 Please read these points carefully and stick to them. EVEN after landing, you should NOT simply drive your car onto fields and meadows. Please try to land in such a way that retrieving is possible without causing damage (driving your car onto a meadow or field IS causing damage!). And just in case, please take photos and report this to us with coordinates so that we can respond to any complaints. Please remember that we want to hold a European Championship here next year with 85 participants and promote it positively!
