Entry fee: € 290,00

Entry fee does not include propane

Propane will be available and be charged according to consumption (prices will be announced one week prior to the competition)

Together with the entry fee you have to pay a gas deposit of € 200,00 which will be credited on your final payment of gas consumed.

Registration process starts on November 1st, 2025.

Registration Deadline will be on March 31st, 2026.
