

## **General Briefing notes**

- The separation altitude between 2D and 3D scoring in this event is 1000 ft MSL
- In this competition we use UTM WGS84. The Coordinates will be given in 5/4 Format (XXXXX / XXXX) with Altitude in ft MSL. Pilot declared Coordinates must be given with Altitude in ft. In case of a missing altitude for the declared coordinate, the goal is invalid.
- Official CLP Coordinates:

CLP 1 62442/3183 – 477ft CLP 2 61545/3900 – 508ft CLP 3 62322/3134 – 486ft

- Blue and red PZs are excluded from the competition area declaring or creating valid waypoints in these areas is not possible

- Recall will do by messaging system and, if possible, on-airband radio on 122.255MHz. The recall message will be copied to the Electronic Notice Board (ENB) as soon as possible.

### **SPECIAL NOTES**

- The large lake about 2km x 10km in diameter. Be cautious about the wind speed and direction and take extra care in your calculations. There is another similar lake further west.
- South-easterly and South-westerly wind directions will take you parallel to the lake and river
  and bordering forest areas which can be challenging to find landing spots. Be sure to stay
  clear of those directions.
- 15km southward is the start of a mountain range with scarce landing spots. Be sure to land well before them in the valley.
- 10km northeast of Prelog is the Hungarian border. **DO NOT cross the border**! Be sure to land before the forested area around the Mura River which is the border.
- North of Prelog there is a major powerline that branches westward, northward, and eastward. Take note of it on the map and exercise caution.
