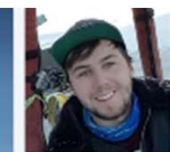
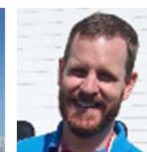
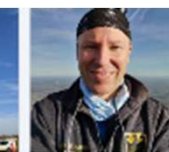
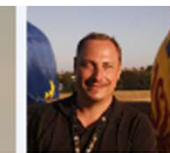
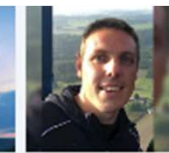
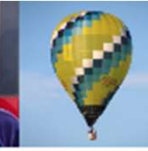
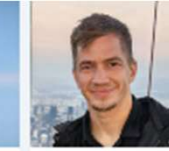
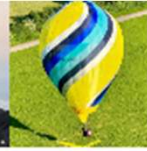
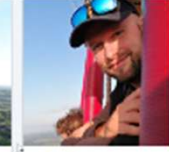
- Entrance via „Kapellenweg 5, 96138 Burgebrach“

Safety

- Kein kaltes Abblasen von Propan.
- Vor dem Start des Ventilators Ballonkorb an Fahrzeug anbinden, nicht an Anhänger.
- Rauchverbot beim Ballonfahren und beim Füllen der Zylinder mit Propan. Beim Füllen sind immer Handschuhe und am besten bedeckende Kleidung zu tragen.
- Hörbereitschaft auf der Ballonfrequenz (122,255) bis zum Start.
- Deutsche Verkehrsregeln sind einzuhalten. Nicht vergessen, in Deutschland wird auf der rechten Seite der Straße gefahren.
- Jeder Unfall muss sofort an den Sicherheitsbeauftragten gemeldet werden.
- Do not release unburned propane.
- Before starting the fan, attach the balloon basket to the vehicle, not to the trailer.
- Do not smoke during the flight and filling the cylinders with propane. When filling always wear gloves and, ideally, protective clothing.
- Listen to the balloon frequency (122,255) until take-off.
- German traffic regulations must be observed. Remember that in Germany, people drive on the right side of the road.
- Any accident must be reported immediately to the safety officer.

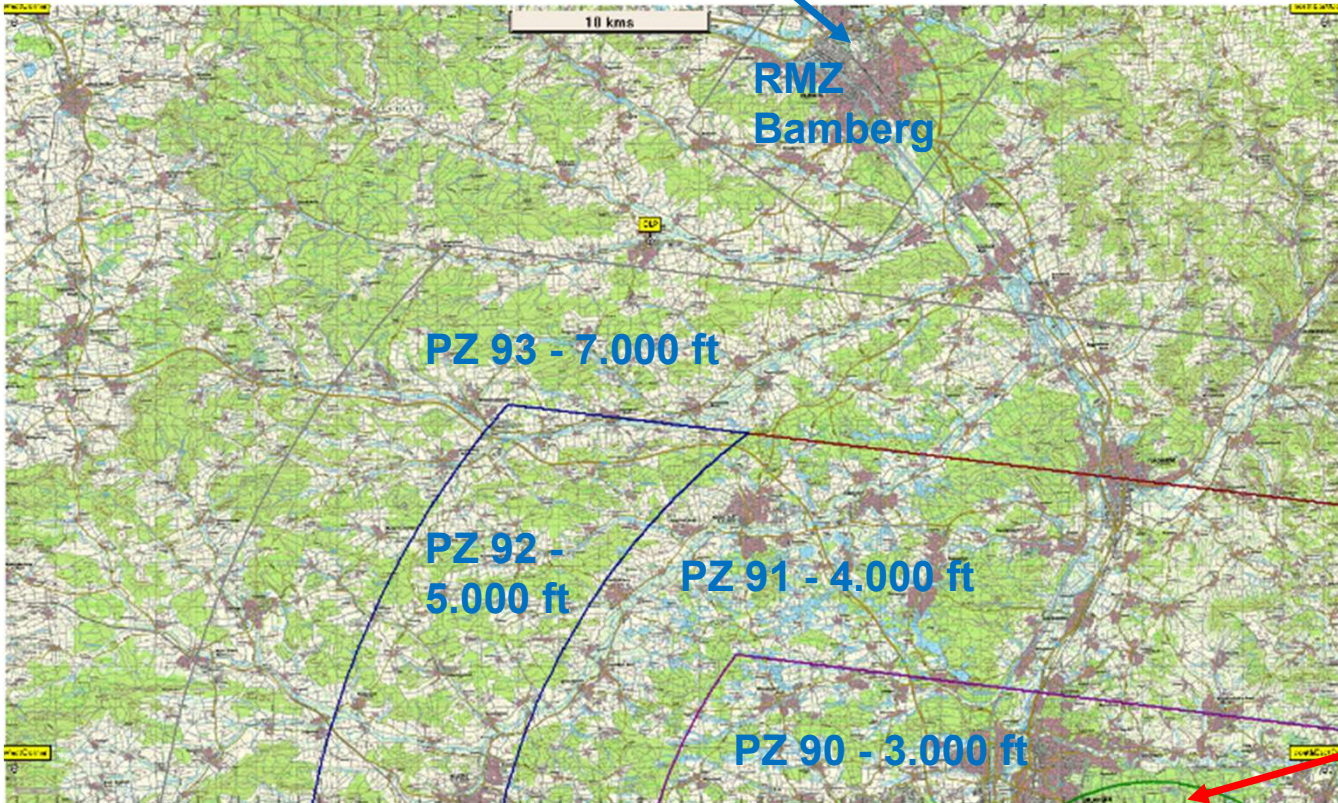
