Inform about the art and status of the incident/accident

- 1 What has happened
- 2 Location (street or place and position with co-ordinates if possible)
- 3 What phone number you are calling from
- 4 If calling from a non-Spanish mobile phone - do not forget to tell the country code
- 5 How many people are injured
- 6 What kind of injuries
- 7 Competition number if possible
