An electronic mark is considered valid if the recorded track point meets all scoring criteria defined in the TDS.

In this TDS, we defined the scoring criteras as a set time limit in which this mark must be made.

The actual result of pilot #36 is a “No Result”

Answer to the actual request:

According to the current task setting (R15.11), the requested mark has to be handled according to the rule 12.17.2.

The mark did not meet the set scoring criteria.

The rule about distance infringement (13.3.6) is not applicable, as time criteria are absolute.

So the scoring is correct due to the reason, that the mark is not valid and stays as it is.
