

Reply to protest

On task #32 (ELB) of flight 8 (21.08.2025 AM)

The Jury received the protest and protest fee. The protest was made in accordance with the Sporting Code and the rules. All timing conditions were met and the protest was admitted.

The Jury invited the competitor Uwe Schneider and the Event Director Martin Wegner to a hearing on August 22nd, 2025 at 10:00. All three Jury members were present. The hearing lasted for 13 minutes and both parties were given the opportunity to explain their arguments in detail.

Finding of the Jury:

The task was set by the director in accordance with the rules and Sporting Code.

As the task details were based on timings rather than distances, the rules under 13.3., more specifically 13.3.6 do not apply.

The more general rules 12.9.2 and 12.17.2 still stand and no other exception for minor infringements of timing (as defined in 13.3. for distance infringements) were found in the rules.

The rules 12.9.2 and 12.17.2 must therefore be applied and the result has been calculated accordingly.

Decision of the Jury:

The protest is not upheld and the scores remain as published.
The Jury also decided not to return the protest fee.

The decisions by the Jury were unanimous.


