

# **GENERAL BRIEFING NOTES**

During briefings, pilots', crew's and officials' mobile phones should be switched off or silent.

#### **II.9 AIR LAW**

The sentence

"If a pilot decides to flight above 6000 ft he must contact Pisa airport approach by radio 124.275."

should be read as

"You will not be penalized for a PZ1 infringement if you fly above 3000 ft AMSL. **HOWEVER**, if you decide to fly above 3000 ft, you **MUST** contact:

- Lucca AFIS before climbing to 3000 ft by radio on 122.500.
- Pisa approach while staying above 3000 ft by radio on 126.080."

#### **II.12 - GOALS SELECTED BY A COMPETITOR**

For scoring, the result will be the distance between a valid electronic mark and the declared goal, calculated in accordance with Rule II.22, unless otherwise stated on the TDS.

Note: If a competitor is required to declare the altitude of a goal and it is declared below the ground or no altitude is declared, they will be scored to the 2D/3D separation altitude. Any distance infringements will then be applied to the goal as if it were declared at the separation altitude (see Rule 13.3.6)

## 6.3 - FLIGHT REPORT FORM (FRF)

Note: The information on the FRF, particularly timing information and estimated results, greatly assist the scoring team to produce timely and accurate results. Landowner information must also be included. Pilot has no rights to complain about the results if he didn't provide his estimation results, except the tasks (LND, 3D, AirBand)which requiring additional calculations.

## 8.2.2 - VALID TASK

Note: Task scores are considered published when they have been posted on the Official Notice Board and/or the ENB as "Official". Measuring lists and "Provisional" scores are not considered to be "task scores".

## 12.3 - DECLARATIONS BY COMPETITORS

There are no predefined goals with 3 digit goal numbers for this competition. Goals must be declared in 4/4 format using the UTM coordinates of the competition map. Alternative methods may be described for individual tasks according to the TDS. Declaring the altitude is only necessary if required by the TDS.
