


## Weather Briefing 1515 Tuesday 9th May 2023 Valid 1530-1830

**Situation:** A slow moving high in the Bight is directing a strong northwesterly airflow over the flying area while a low pressure trough approaches from the west. The trough will move through the local area later today ahead of a cold front which is expected to bring a southwesterly change around midday Wednesday. Conditions are becoming unstable ahead of this system and there is a chance of an afternoon shower or two and the possibility of an isolated storm.



**SURFACE WIND:** 310/05-09kt.

**WEATHER:** Isolated shower. Isolated storm.

CLOUD: SCT 5000ft, SCT 11000ft.

**VISIBILITY:** Unrestricted.

TURB: Moderate near cloud/showers

and below 4000ft. Severe near
