A highly accomplished and award-winning Australian hot-air balloon pilot, Nicola has been hot air ballooning for 20 years. She is a three-time winner of the FAI Women's World Hot Air Balloon Championship, the only pilot, female or male to win three world championship titles. Starting competitive ballooning in 2013, she rapidly progressed through national and international ranks to become a formidable competition pilot. Her strengths include precision, consistency, focus and leadership. She combines her competitive career with commercial operations and has a strong emphasis on supporting and advocating for women in ballooning.
